How could this course improve?

01 He focused a lot on derivations. While I find derivations to be interesting, they are more the kind of thing I appreciate over a shot of whiskey and a cigar casually reading in my study. Being an engineering student is a gruesome and brutal experience, and his lectures were too much for my brain to handle with the 60+ hours a week spend on school and understanding.

I would, and many of my classmates who I have conversed with say they would prefer him to focus more on explaining the equations, what they mean, when and how to use them, and to cover content in a fashion more directly useful to making things. This is a late stage class and by this point we want material that is directly applicable to making things, not to advancing understanding of the discipline. As much as I would love to learn the things he discusses, I don't feel it is the right time or place.

How could the professor/instructor improve?
