
I would like the examples done in class to match homework/exam questions better.

Comments

Go through notes faster and focus on what will be practiced on hw

Prove less of the theories so you have time for all of the course material you want to cover. I'm not sure what we didn't cover, but I recall you starting every class saying we were behind. But really that was the only issue. Besides that 10/10!

Possibly offer some worked examples of similar problems to the homework. The textbook offers some formulas and examples laid out in more difficult manners than in class. The notes and in class problems help, but more examples can't hurt.

What would you tell another student who asked you to describe this course?

Comments

As long as you do the homeworks, then you'll do well on the exams. The professor and the TA are really good at answering questions so do not hesitate to ask them for help.

Very similar to fluid mechanics

Do homework as soon as it is assigned. It is very hard and can't be completed last minute.

A faster pace lecture style, ask questions at any point in time, and go to AI sessions if you need help! The homework is doable if you ask questions and don't procrastinate.

Difficult to initially grasp, but once the base information has been understood, the material builds on itself in a reasonable and logical manner.


